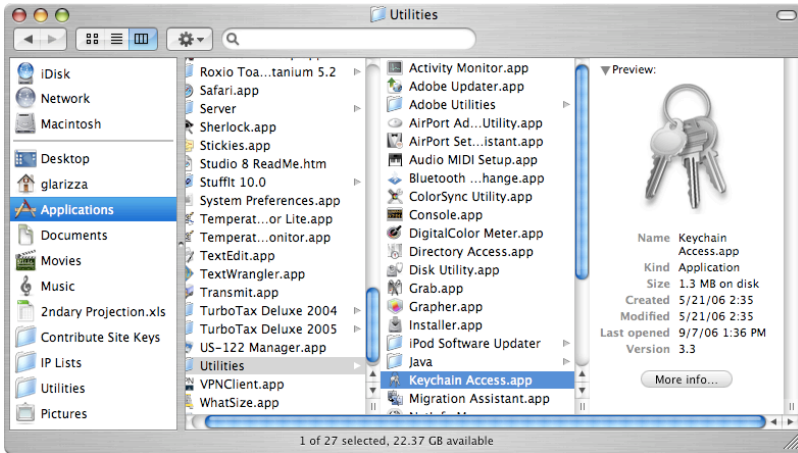
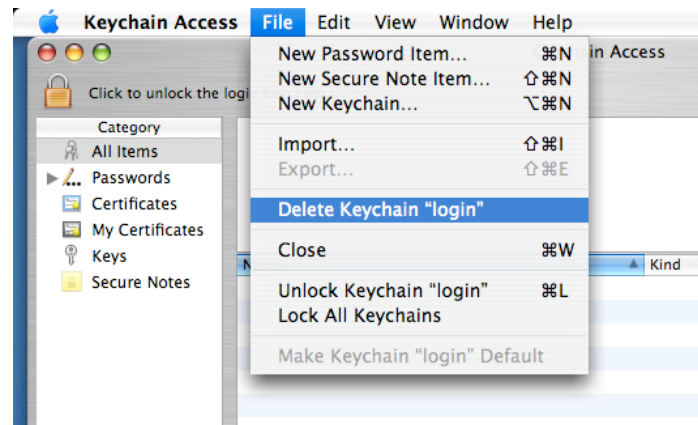


Safari “Login Password” Glitch



Open the Hard Drive on your desktop, open the Applications folder, and then the Utilities Folder inside that folder. There should be a program called “Keychain Access.” Double-click that icon to run the program.

Once you’ve opened Keychain Access, go to the File menu and select “Delete Keychain ‘login’.”

The references to be deleted refer to files on your disk. Do you wish to delete only the references and not the related files?

When asked if you want to Delete the keychain, click the “Delete References and Files” button (it’s **NOT** the blue button) on the left.

After you’ve deleted the References and Files, you can close the Keychain Access program. Next, open Safari and browse through a couple of web pages (sometimes Progress Book makes this go faster) until you receive the error message on the right. When you see this message, click the “Reset to Defaults” button.





Click "Yes" through this button to confirm the reset.

This is the Final Step in fixing the glitch. You must enter the password that you use to login to your computer. This is the password that you use when you restart your computer and it asks you for your username and password. Frequently, it's a word and then numbers.
