

## Third Quarter Book Report Assignment for Holocaust Selection

By now, you should have your book and should be reading it. Once you have finished reading your book, go to Step 1.

### **Step 1: Choose 1 of the following 4 items to design to showcase the book you read.**

**Choice 1: Newspaper project** – for this project, you will create a 2 page newspaper that tells about events and characters in your book. The newspaper may include weather reports, an editorial, editorial cartoons, etc – that relate to the story. Your newspaper should be titled something appropriate for the book you read. It should also include the date your story takes place (if applicable). You also need columns, and titles for each article (with a minimum of 2 well-written articles that provide adequate information about your book). You also need to include at least 2 pictures that support your newspaper and are relative to the book.

**Choice 2: Powerpoint Presentation** – for this project, you must include the following:

- 1 title slide with the title and author of the book,
- 1 slide for each setting of the story (ideally 2-5 slides). Each slide needs to identify the setting and include an image to illustrate the setting.
- 3 character slides (choose the 3 main or most important characters/people in your book and provide information about them along with a picture if applicable).
- 2 slides identifying conflicts/problems in the story
- 3 slides detailing major/important events in the story
- 1 -3 resolution slides (the number of slides will vary based on your book)

\*prior to your presentation date, I need to see and approve your slides\*

**Choice 3: Create a Pamphlet/Brochure** – for this project, identify an issue or cause that was very important to your character. Once you have identified this issue, create a pamphlet or brochure aimed at persuading others of the importance of this issue. Include factual information, testimonials, pictures and/or graphics. Be sure to cite your sources for your testimonials (see me if you need help with this). This project would look better if typed.

**Choice 4: Poster Presentation** – for this project, you will need a full-sized poster board. On your board, include the title and author of your book. Include at least 3 facts about 3 or more major characters (include pictures if applicable). Then, include a 2-3 sentence statement about the setting along with at least 2 pictures/images. Next, identify the plot of the story with words and images (rising action, climax, resolution). Your poster should include images and adjectives to illustrate and describe your book.

### **Step 2 - Prove It in Five Minutes!**

You will be giving a 2-3 minute presentation of your book and project. This presentation should include your opinion and recommendation of the book. Then, your classmates will have 2 minutes to ask you questions about your book. If you are able to effectively answer the class's questions and your presentation adequately demonstrates that you read the book, you will be exempt from completing a written book report assignment.
